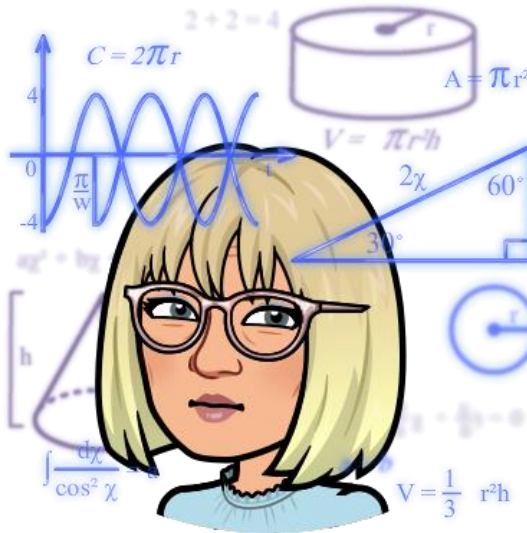




# The Emmanuel Eye
