











Historical Concepts

|  Legacy | Something handed down from ancestors or from the past. |
|  Society | Human beings together with common traditions. |
|  Civilisation | The society, culture and way of life of a particular area. |
|  Invasion | An unwelcome and hostile entry for conquest of another area. |
|  Settlement | A place where people live. |
|  Equality | The right of different groups of people to have a similar social position and receive the same treatment. |
|  Freedom | The power of a people to act, speak and think as they choose. |
|  Diversity | Including people from a range of different social and ethnic backgrounds. |
|  Conflict | A struggle, battle or clash of interests, opinions or principles. |
|  Significance | The meaningful importance of events or of and individual. |
