EAT FABULOUS FOOD – FOR FREE!

If your Child is in Reception, Year 1, or Year 2, they don't just have access to delicious daily dinners every School Day with The Pantry - **they won't cost you a penny, either!** As part of the Government's Universal Infant Free School Meal Scheme, every Key Stage 1 pupil in a Government-funded School is entitled to a free School Meal each day - one *more* reason to book a meal with The Pantry.

And your child might be entitled to Free School Meals from Years 3-6 if you receive any of the following:

- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
